TREE DECORATING GUIDELINES

Trees can be decorated at the venue located at Settler's Green Outlet Village, 2 Common Court, Unit D 32, North Conway, NH. Trees can also be delivered to the venue fully decorated. <u>All trees</u> must be at the venue and fully decorated by Friday, November 22nd at 7pm.

Tree Set-Up:

Monday, November $18^{th} - 2pm$ to 7pm Tuesday, November $19^{th} - 2pm$ to 7pm Wednesday, November $20^{th} - 2pm$ to 7pm Thursday, November $21^{st} - 2pm$ to 7pm Friday, November $22^{nd} - 2pm$ to 7pm

Please call RSVP at 603-356-9331 or email Susan at susan.ccrsvp@gmail.com to set up a time to decorate your tree at the venue. If you cannot decorate your tree during one of the scheduled times listed above, please call RSVP at 603-356-9331 and a staff member will collaborate with you.

LIST OF GUIDELINES

- All trees are artificial and are considered donations to the RSVP Festival of Trees.
- All trees will be raffled, and all items placed with the tree are part of the raffle.
- Trees must have lights, a tree topper and skirt or under tree display. Please keep in mind your tree may be viewed from all sides depending on location.
- The total height cannot exceed nine feet (including the tree topper). A tall tree requires a deep stand or one with a tall gripping mechanism.
- Edible items, even if wrapped or boxed, are not permitted as decorations.
- Loose glitter, confetti, artificial snow, hot gluing or spraying of anything are not allowed in the display area during set up.
- If you have items of value such as gift cards or lottery tickets, please make copies to place on the tree and turn in the originals to the festival team member at check in to be stored for safety and given to tree winner.
- Larger items of value such as products or liquor bottles should be secured to the tree with wire.
- Gift baskets should be wrapped in cellophane to keep contents secured.
- An 8-10" extension cord must be included with the tree. (Extension cord will remain with the tree)
- If the tree requires more than one outlet, please provide a power strip for the tree.
- All decorations on the tree "must" be wired to the tree to allow for easy tree winner transport.
- Helpful items to have when setting up: a stepstool or a ladder if the size of your tree will require one. Scissors, tape, wire, extra lights.
- Please take all the packaging and boxes with you when you leave.
- Do not leave anything overnight if you have not finished decorating.

No trees will be accepted after Friday, November 22nd
